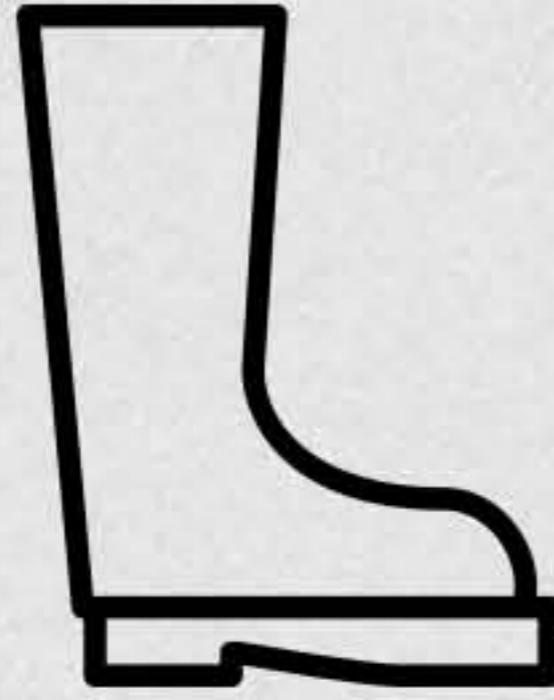




Poultry Biosecurity

Practical tips for commercial farms and backyard flocks.

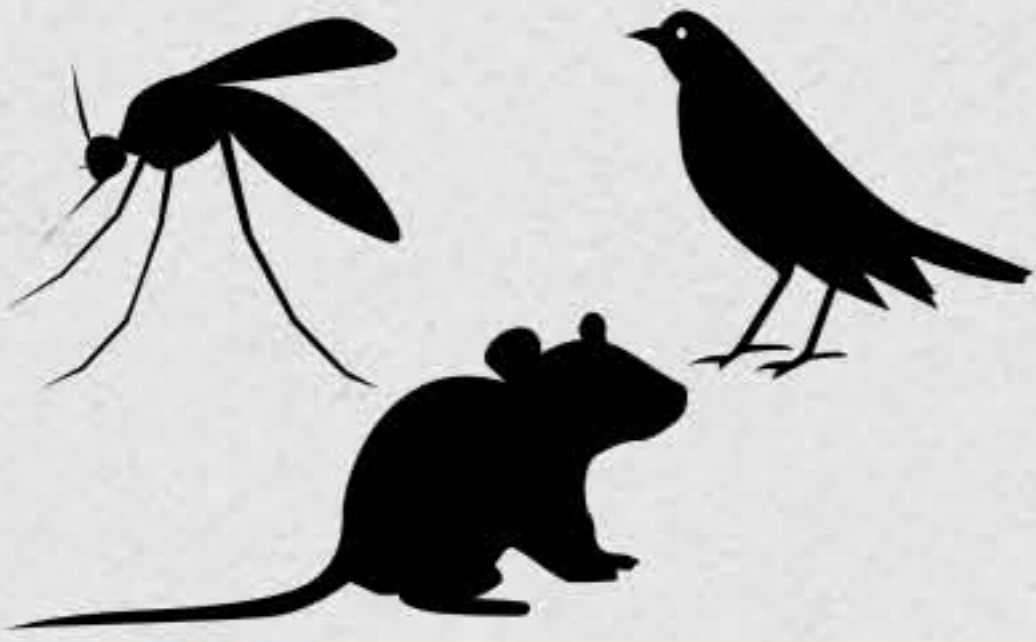


Restrict entry to essential personnel and record entry in visitor log book.

Poultry farmers and visitors to the farms should **change into dedicated/disposable, clean boots and coveralls upon entering the barn.**

Minimize visits to other poultry farms.

If visiting other farms, shower before entering your barn.



Implement a pest control program of wild birds, rodents and insects.

Avoid mixing species of birds or contact with outside birds.

Wash hands and use hand sanitizer before and after handling the birds.



Minimize entry of vehicles, supplies, equipment to your farm, and limit vehicle access to your flock. Clean and disinfect drop off area.

Regularly monitor flock health and immediately report any suspicion of disease to your veterinarian.

Review your biosecurity plan and flock health program with your veterinarian on a regular basis.
