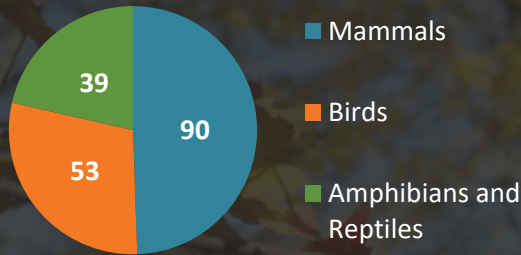




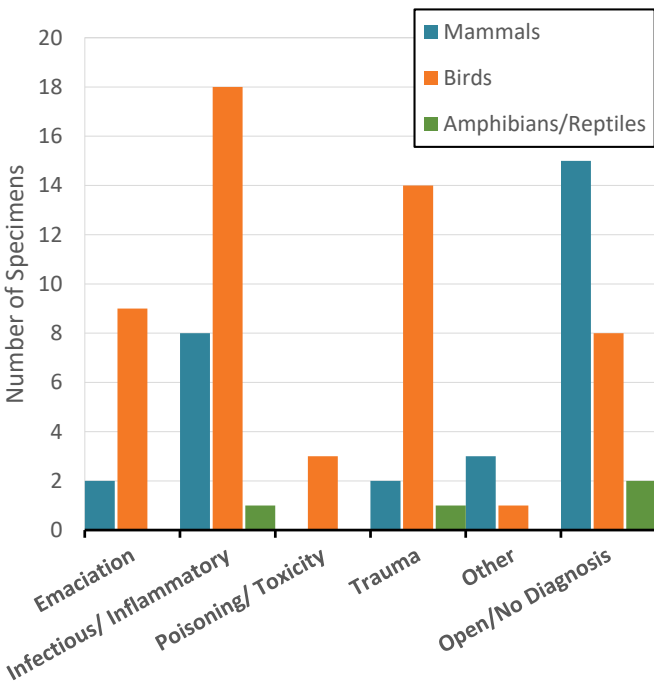

AVIAN INFLUENZA VIRUS - DEAD BIRD SURVEILLANCE		
15	0 Matrix Positive 0 H5 Positive 0 H7 Positive	None of the birds tested for AIV were positive by Matrix PCR.
WEST NILE VIRUS		
10	0	None of the birds tested for West Nile Virus were positive by PCR.
CHRONIC WASTING DISEASE		
12	0	None of the cervids tested positive for CWD by ELISA testing.
SNAKE FUNGAL DISEASE		
38	1 PCR Positive 2 Histopathology Positive	2 snakes tested positive for <i>Ophidiomyces ophiodiicola</i> by PCR and Histopathology. Totals include special project cases.
CANINE DISTEMPER VIRUS		
46	25	There were 25 positive cases of Canine Distemper Virus. Totals include special project cases
